| **Country of origin** | all (except Austria)

| **Area of study or research** | Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Medicine, Agriculture and Forestry, Veterinary Medicine, Social Sciences, Law and Economics, Humanities and Theology, Fine Arts

| **Detailed type of grant** | semester or one-year grant

| **Target Group** | postgraduates, PhD holders

| **Authority awarding grant** | OeAD-GmbH/ICM on behalf of and financed by the BMWF

| **Duration** | 1 to 9 months

### | **Grant benefit paid** |

1) Monthly grant rate

a) for graduates: 940 EUR

b) for graduates over 30 years with a PhD degree: 1,040 EUR

2) Accident and health insurance, accommodation

a) If necessary, the OeAD-GmbH will take out an accident and health insurance on behalf of the grant recipient.

b) Accommodation (student hall of residence or flat) will be provided by the OeAD-GmbH for recipients of grants. Monthly costs: 200 to 380 EUR (depending on how much comfort the recipients of grants want). An administration fee of 15 EUR per month is payable to the OeAD-GmbH for arranging accommodation. The costs for insurance and accommodation have to be paid out of the grant by the recipient of the grant.

3) Recipients of grants are exempted from paying tuition fees.

4) For applicants from non-European developing countries an additional allowance for travel costs may be paid.

### | **Advice on how to apply** |

Eligible for application are

a) postgraduates pursuing a doctoral/PhD programme outside Austria;

b) postgraduates and post-docs wishing to pursue research in Austria with a view to an academic career and who completed their studies (at a university outside Austria) after September 30th, 2008;

c) post-docs who are working as lecturers at a university outside Austria.

(Applicants under a) have to prove that they pursue doctoral/PhD studies, applicants under c) have to prove that they are employed by a university.)

Applicants must not have studied/pursued research/pursued academic work in Austria in the last six months before taking up the grant.

Maximum age: 35 years (born on or after Oct. 1st, 1974).

Good knowledge of German, particularly in the respective subject area, is a prerequisite. For projects to be carried out in English a good knowledge of English in the respective subject area is required. Proof of proficiency in German or English can be attached to the application.

## Ernst Mach Grant for students from non-European countries for studying a fulltime programme at an Austrian university of applied sciences (Fachhochschule)

| **Area of study or research** | Natural Sciences, Technical Sciences, Medicine, Agriculture and Forestry, Veterinary Medicine, Social Sciences, Law and Economics, Humanities and Theology

| **Detailed type of grant** | semester or one-year grant

| **Target Group** | undergraduate students

| **Authority awarding grant** | OeAD-GmbH/ICM on behalf of and financed by the BMWF

| **Duration** | 4 to 10 months

### | **Grant benefit paid** |

1) Monthly grant rate € 940.--

2) Accident and health insurance, accommodation

a) If necessary, the OeAD-GmbH will take out an accident and health insurance on behalf of the grant recipient.

b) Accommodation (student hall of residence or flat) will be provided by the OeAD-GmbH or the Fachhochschule for recipients of grants. Monthly costs: € 200.-- to € 380.--. For accommodation arranged by the OeAD-GmbH an administration fee of € 15.- per month is payable. The costs for insurance and accommodation have to be paid out of the grant by the recipient of the grant.

3) Recipients of grants are exempted from paying tuition fees.

4) For applicants from developing countries an additional allowance for travel costs may be paid.

### | **Advice on how to apply** |

Eligible for application are students who are studying a master programme at a university in one of the above-mentioned countries or who have successfully completed at least 4 semesters of studies within a diploma programme at a university in one of the above-mentioned countries at the time of taking up the grant.

Maximum age: 35 years (born on or after October 1st, 1974).

Applicants must not have studied/pursued research/pursued academic work in Austria in the last six months before taking up the grant.

Proof of proficiency in the language of instruction (German or English) has to be provided.

The confirmation of admission by the Fachhochschule degree programme of your choice has to be enclosed with the application. (Therefore please contact the Fachhochschule degree programme of your choice in time.)

The study programmes on offer at the Austrian universities of applied sciences (Fachhochschulen) and Fachhochschule degree programmes can be found at <http://www.fhk.ac.at>. The topics of the study programmes can roughly be summarised as follows: "Economics/Business", "Tourism", "Economics and Technology", "Technology/Biotechnology", "Media and Design" as well as "Health and Social Matters".
