

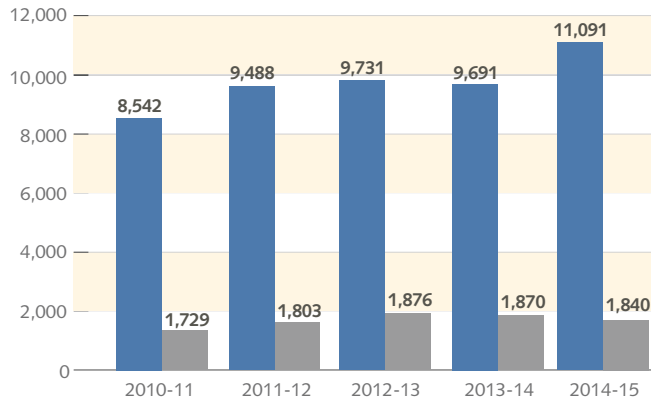

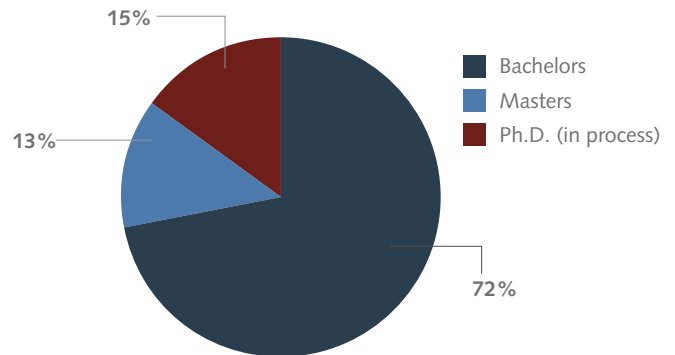

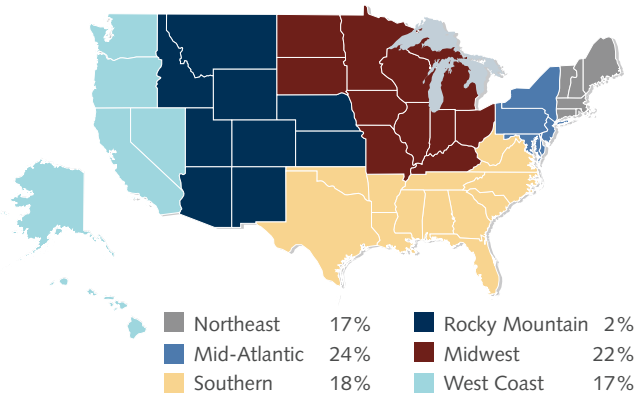
Fulbright U.S. Student Program Applicants and Recipients

Fulbright-Clinton Fellowship

- Fellows serve in professional placements in foreign government ministries or institutions and carry out an academic research/study project.
- For 2014-15, Fellows have been placed in the African Union, Bangladesh, Burma, Cote d'Ivoire, Guatemala, Haiti, Kazakhstan, Kosovo, Malawi, Nepal, Samoa and Timor-Leste.

Fulbright-mtvU Award

- Grantees pursue an academic project which explores the power of music as a global force for mutual understanding.
- The 2014-15 grantees are conducting research in Ghana, Japan, Zambia, Iceland and the United Arab Emirates.

Fulbright-National Geographic Digital Storytelling Fellowship

- Fellows participate in an academic year of overseas travel in up to three countries, sharing their research and experience on a National Geographic blog supported by National Geographic editors.
- The inaugural 2014-15 Fellows are pursuing their projects in Botswana, Cambodia, Canada, Mexico and the United Kingdom.

Fulbright U.S. Student Program Overview

- The **Fulbright U.S. Student Program** offers research, study and teaching opportunities in over 130 countries to recent graduates and graduate students.
- Applications** to this program have grown by 30 percent over the last five years, and grants awarded have increased by 6 percent.
- A network of nearly 1,600 volunteer **Fulbright Program Advisers** on campuses nationwide assist in the recruitment.
- More than 3,600 candidates are recommended by 157 subsections of the **National Screening Committee**, composed of 457 senior faculty or field of study professionals.
- The **gender** breakdown for U.S. Fulbright Student grantees is 67 percent female and 33 percent male.
