DI Dr. Judith Eiblmayr, born in Vienna in 1964, is an architect, architectural critic and curator. Coming from a family of architects she studied architecture at the Vienna University of Technology, where she earned a doctorate, and at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. Judith Eiblmayr has regularly contributed articles on architecture, urban planning, cultural history, and design to professional journals including the architecture page of Die Presse's *Spectrum*, to which she was the main contributor for 17 years until 2013. She is the author and editor of numerous books on architecture and design including "Haus Hoch," the landmark high rise on Herrengasse in Vienna's 1st district, where her own architecture office www.eiblmayr.at is located. In 2015-2016 Judith Eiblmayr was the Fulbright-University of Minnesota Visiting Professor at the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities.
