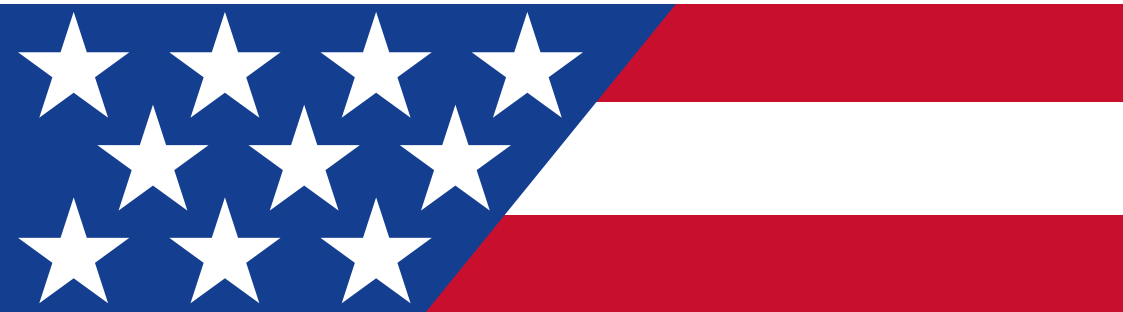

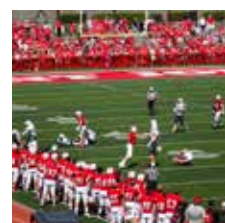
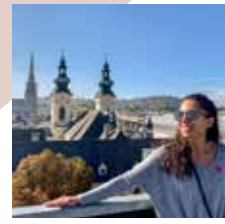

Get a master's degree in the US!

Fulbright awards change lives and enhance careers. The Austrian Fulbright Student Program provides generous financial and administrative support to Austrian students and young professionals who have completed their first degrees and are interested in pursuing a master's degree in the US.

- ★ Grant of up to \$35,000 to pay tuition and living costs
- ★ Travel and relocation allowance of €2,000

AUSTRIAN FULBRIGHT SCHOLAR PROGRAM

Your benefits

- ★ Monthly maintenance grant (minimum value: \$4,000)
- ★ Travel and relocation allowance of €1,500
- ★ Additional benefits based on the award

The Austrian Fulbright Scholar Program serves up-and-coming as well as established scholars with a PhD or similar qualification. It provides early- and mid-career professionals, academics, and researchers with opportunities to teach and pursue research at institutions in the US for 3–4 months.

FULBRIGHT FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING ASSISTANT PROGRAM

Participants in the Foreign Language Teaching Assistant (FLTA) Program spend an academic year living, teaching German, and studying on a US university campus. FLTAs use their skills as native speakers to enliven their classrooms and share Austrian culture with their students.

US FULBRIGHT STUDENT PROGRAM

Study and research in Austria!

The US Fulbright Student Program provides recent graduates, graduate students, and PhD candidates with opportunities to study or conduct research in Austria for an academic year. Our “combined grants” enable students to work part time as secondary-school teachers while also pursuing research projects or volunteering at local community and cultural organizations.

Your benefits

- ★ Monthly stipend (minimum value: €1,250)
- ★ Travel and relocation allowance of €2,000
- ★ Reimbursement for health insurance and residency permit costs
- ★ Enrollment and tuition remission at an Austrian public university
- ★ Participation in enrichment activities

The US Fulbright Scholar Program offers exciting opportunities for leading US academics and artists to engage with students and faculty for 4–6 months at Fulbright Austria's wide variety of partner institutions, which include universities, universities of applied sciences, research centers, and museums all over Austria.

US TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIP PROGRAM

Through this program, which Fulbright Austria administers on behalf of the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research (BMBWF), US citizens with at least a bachelor’s degree and intermediate-mid German proficiency spend an academic year teaching English in Austrian secondary schools for 13 hours per week and exploring the diversity of both Austrian and US culture together with their students.

FULBRIGHT SPECIALIST PROGRAM

The Fulbright Specialist Program pairs highly qualified US academics and professionals with Austrian host institutions to share their expertise, strengthen institutional ties, gain international experience, and learn about Austrian culture while building capacity at their Austrian host institution for 2–6 weeks. All Austrian institutions are eligible to apply.

Founded in 1946, the Fulbright Program is named after J. William Fulbright (1905–1995). Senator Fulbright believed in the fundamental importance of international relations and was instrumental in creating a program that aims to cultivate “perceptions and perspectives that transcend national boundaries.” Initially, the program converted the proverbial swords of war into plowshares of peace by selling surplus war property overseas to finance an unprecedented number of bilateral educational and cultural exchanges for students, scholars, and teachers. Today, the Fulbright Program facilitates these bilateral exchanges between the US and 155 countries around the globe. Fulbright Austria was founded in 1951, making it one of the oldest Fulbright commissions in the world.
